

The Coca-Cola Company 2008 U.S. Political Contributions Report

Corporate contributions are legally permitted political donations using the Company's financial resources. While corporations are not permitted to contribute to U.S. federal political campaigns or to the national political parties, they can contribute to state and local candidates in many jurisdictions as well as to the "party building activities" of the national parties.

The **Company's political action committee** – or "Coke PAC" – is a voluntary employee program funded by employee contributions and donations are made to U.S. federal candidates, committees and parties.

The **Georgia Political Action Fund** – or "GPAF" – is a legal entity set up to make contributions to state and local candidates, committees and political parties in Georgia. Corporate political contributions are permitted in Georgia.
